Dear EMT Candidate,

Thank you for your interest in our EMT program. The EMT class will be 6p to 10:30pm Monday and Tuesdays with occasional Saturdays from 8am to 4pm each month. The class schedule will be given out the first night so everyone can plan ahead. The cost is \$975, there will be a 150 dollar non-refundable deposit due with the application (we have to order books and supplies). The course cost includes the textbook, class tuition, and the on line access, this class is hybrid, meaning that all students will have access to course compass, all exams and assignments are done at home over the week, this maximizes class time for learning the practical skills and lectures. The class fee also covers the Trauma First Response course, a new class from NAEMT for EMT students that teaches the PHTLS principals of trauma care, the class is free to students and is voluntary; the students just need to buy the textbook. We also offer free to the students the PEPP class Pedi Education for the Pre-Hospital Provider, again the student buys the textbook and the class is free.

In addition we offer the students at the end of the program free of charge 2 FEMA courses, WMD Radiological/Nuclear Awareness and IRTB Incident Response to Terrorist Bombings classes, these are 2 4 hour nights at the end of the class and it gives the student 2 additional FEMA certificates. We require that the student on their own time go on line and do IS 100 and 700 that can be done over the course. Finally we are now offering an EMT safety, self-defense program taught by Progressive Defense Systems for a small charge.

Here is the best news, all my instructors are committed to the student's success, and so far from our last class all students that tested passed the written and practical on the first try. We cannot guarantee this about you but what we will guarantee is that we will run a highly respected EMT training program. The program is fully OEMS accredited as well. Our EMT training exceeds the DOT curriculum and students can sit for the national registry exam for EMT's if they choose to do so.
